Too often, domestic abuse follows survivors to work. As workplace violence becomes more common, the costs to employers escalate and the safety of employees is threatened. The goal of Harbor House's Key Business Initiative is to eliminate violent crime and homicides in local workplaces, improve access to services for survivors and reduce employer costs. #### **CELL PHONE DRIVES**

Donated cell phones are used to provide emergency phones to survivors of domestic abuse. Many batterers install GPS systems and tracking software on victims' phones, making them unsafe to use. Donations of old cell phones allow us to provide phones to survivors so they can remain safe, with access to emergency help if needed. Your old cell phone could literally save a life. Create a collection area in your office, and ask coworkers for their old phones. You'll be amazed at how many you can collect!
