## **WHY SUPPORT HARBOR HOUSE**

Amira\* came to Harbor House's office in the Orange County Courthouse last year. She and her husband were originally from the Middle East and had been in the U.S. for a few years. Suffering from constant physical, emotional, and financial abuse since they first wed, Amira feared he would make good on his threats to kill her. Our court advocates worked with Amira, and she was granted a temporary injunction right away. Amira made a plan with them and was able to get herself and her son out of the house and immediately came into our emergency shelter.

With one of our IFP attorneys, she secured a five-year injunction and worked closely with the Economic Empowerment Coordinator in shelter to learn about financial safety planning, how to budget, and seeking out services in the community. Amira is overcoming her fears as she gains independence. She used her new skills and confidence to save for and purchase her own car and is pursuing a divorce from her abuser. Amira already had an undergraduate degree and is pursuing her master's. She now has a full-time job in her chosen career field while attending school. Throughout this process, Amira's son was well taken care of in our on-site childcare facility. He recently started pre-kindergarten and is doing great! Harbor House helped Amira find housing with our transitional housing program and she is thriving and will continue to work towards independence and a life free of abuse and control.
